Jewelry Frame Art Kit

1 Jewelry frame, predrilled

11 holes on front (for knobs) 4 on top (for ring holder hooks) 2 on back (for hanging kit) 11 variety knobs with hardware 4 ring holder hooks with hardware* 3 chains with 6 small wires to attach to knobs Hanging kit with wire Black and white paint Paint brush 1 Pen/screwdriver

Plastic sheet is needed for necklace making kit. Do not discard.

*The ring holder hooks have only one screw instead of 2, as this will allow you to gently rotate it as needed.

Artist tip: If you have a special knob(s) of your own, you may be able to swap as needed if they can use the same size screws.

Step 1 (Optional)

Determine the color of your jewelry frame. All kits come with black and white paint and a paint brush. Use individually, mix them for different shades of gray, or don't use them at all. Frame should be fully dry.

Step 2 – Design

Do not attach knobs in this step (attach chain first)

Bonus Necklace Making Kit

1 glass cabochon with metal back Adjustable necklace cord with clasp Paint colors Plastic sheet for creating "acrylic skins" Drink straw Single use super glue

Prepare

- Lay the plastic out on a flat surface
- Artist tip: this plastic will allow the paint to peel off when dry
- Cut the paint strip into individual pots, then open.

Arrange the knobs as you'd like on the front. There is no "right way", it's only your way. Take a picture of your arrangement.

Step 3 – Attach chains

- The first three rows of knobs will have chains linked to them. Arrange the chains how you'd like. Artist tip: chains should not be too tight. There should be a little wiggle room or "give" to hang elegantly.
- Using the small wires, thread one wire on one end of the last link or two of chain, and twist the wire around the screw.
- Do the same for the other side. It's ok to use an inner link of the chain so that it's not too tight or too loose .

Step 4 – Attach knobs

Screw the knobs into their places, per your design

Step 5 - Attach ring holder hooks

- Using the included screwdriver (twist off the silver piece beneath the stylus to uncover the screwdriver. Pull out the screwdriver bit and flip for the Philips head.
- Attach the ring holder hooks on the top of the frame. (see pictures)

Step 6 – Attach hanging kit

Using the screwdriver, attach the metal hanging hooks, and then add the wire, making sure that it is somewhat tight, but not too tight. Hang it up! I have mine right next to my mirror.

Step 7 - Hang frame and add your jewelry - For a lifetime!

Instructions

- Pour paints onto plastic, one color on top of the other 1.
- Use the back of the paint brush to swirl. Let paint settle 2. and dry, or
- 3. Use the straw to blow paint slightly, then let paint settle and dry. Do not make paint too thin or won't peel easily.
- 4. Wait for the paint to fully dry.
- Gently peel paint from the plastic. 5.
- 6. Use your cabochon glass to identify which part of the paint you'd like to capture. Trim the paint skin and attach to the glass and metal back with glue.

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
